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Greetings! As I pack up the Red Queen and Bettina Florida Class kits ... I thought of a few examples of things you might enjoy knowing about!

ACRYLIC PAINTING STATION!

And supplies. For those of you that paint with acrylics, or would like to start learning how to add more to your purchased China Painted dolls ... here is EXACTLY what I use!

Ceramcoat is my paint of choice - I like the way it flows on (thickness), and general texture. I use a basic 5 color theme ...

ALWAYS

Black, White, Trail TAN

THEN

lip color (reds or pinks)
eye color
and eye shadow

Notice the POST IT NOTE that I put the paint on! BEFORE you stick the post it note to table, put a few drops of water ... then put the post it note on top. The paper will absorb the water and keep the acrylic paint from drying out as quick!
