

CROCHET DAINTY COIN PURSE- *the thinner the needle and cotton the smaller the purse.*

Start with 6 chain. Join chain with a single stitch. Single crochet 8 times into circle. Double crochet into the top of each single crochet. Continue until bag measures 1 inch. LAST ROW- 6 single crochet into every second stitch, alternative stitch a single stitch. this will; form a shell edge .

When complete, join two sides together to form a roll. Thread a piece of thin 2mm ribbon through the row beneath the shell edge and pull up tight - add a bead on the end of each end of the ribbon.

CROCHET CLOAK

MATERIALS:

Hook: Size .60

Yarn: A nice soft cotton would work well - thin equal to DMC 80

Stitches used: ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc.

HOOD:

ROW 1: Chain 15, sc in 2nd ch from hk and in each ch across (14sc). Ch 1, turn.

ROWS 2-6: Sc in bl of each sc. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 7: Fold piece with short ends together. While folded, sl st the long end together (wrong side). Turn hood right side out.

SKIRT:

ROW 1: Attach yarn to bottom corner of the right front side of hood with sl st. {this is the end of the very 1st row you did}. Ch 1, working in ends of rows, evenly space 16 hdc across bottom of hood. Ch 2, turn.

ROW 2: Hdc in each hdc. Ch 2, turn.

ROW 3: *Hdc in next hdc, 2 hdc in next hdc. Repeat from * across. Ch 3, turn.

ROW 4: (dc, ch 2, sc) in same st as beg ch 3. *Skip next st, (2dc, ch 2, sc) in next st. Repeat from * across. Dc in last st. Ch 1, turn.

ROW 5: * (2dc, ch 2, sc) in next ch 2 sp. Repeat from * across. Dc in last st. Ch 1, turn.

ROWS 6-11: Repeat Row 5.

Fasten off and neatly weave ends into crochet work.

If you want the cloak to be longer - **REPEAT ROW 5 as many times as you would like to add the length.**

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
