

## Wigging Cross

**1. Take hank of viscose.** Gently grasp ends and pull apart to width and length desired. Mist with mister filled with drop of fabric softener to still frizzies. Then slide between fingers to take away any frizzies.



\*\*\*Smooth! The **photo to the left** shows how smooth your viscose must be **BEFORE** you begin wigging ... if you want a professional hairstyle.

**2. Glue a realistic hairline on doll's head.** Now lay strip of hair from nose to neck and gently press into glue. Next place a strip of glue from ear to ear. Lay viscose across this part. Let dry and then style as desired.

(You can do this with straight viscose .... or viscose that has been pleated. Remember to gently \*comb\* with a corsage pin to style)



**3. Make sure to have a clean, neat forehead line** when you lift up your front section of hair. Re-glue hairline if needed. You can also take your fingernail and scrape back a line of glue/hair that is too low.

Wigging - 3 steps



Protect your doll while wigging (if she is dressed) by using a plastic baggie (see above photo).
